

ADIRONDACK SWIMMING OBSERVED MEETS

Observed Meets are those meet which are not governed by USA Swimming Rules, where a request for Observation has been made in advance with the Sanction/Times Chair. These would include High School and College meets. Once a request to have the meet Observed is made, **it is up to the SWIMMERS to make requests to have their times loaded to SWIMS.** This can be done by using our AD Forms for either an individual swimmer or a team can use the list style form. **Once completed, the form must be submitted to the computer table at the meet. REQUESTS ARE NOT ACCEPTED AFTER THE MEET IS OVER.** Be sure to submit your request on time.

YOU MUST BE A CURRENT USA SWIMMING REGISTERED ATHLETE TO HAVE YOUR TIMES LOADED TO SWIMS.

After the meet, the AD Sanction/Times Chair will update the meet file to contain the correct SWIMS data for each swimmer who had made a request, using one of the forms and load the result times to SWIMS. In the case of High School or College meets, **NO RELAY TIMES WILL BE AUTOMATICALLY LOADED TO SWIMS** because in order for a relay to be legal, all 4 members must be current members of the same USA Swimming Club. In addition, **RELAY LEAD OFF SPLITS ARE NOT AUTOMATICALLY LOADED.** **If you have a leadoff split in a relay which is a BEST TIME for you, you must contact the Sanction/Times Chair to request the time loaded to SWIMS. Remember, YOU MUST HAVE ALREADY SUBMITTED A REQUEST FORM, TO HAVE YOUR TIMES LOADED.**
