Entry Rules:

The eligibility of a swimmer will be determined by his or her age on January 13, 2007.
Rules from the current USA Swimming Technical Rules will be in effect.
Entries must be submitted on floppy diskette or CD using the Hy-Tek Meet Manager or Team Manager Software.
Team entries must be received by **Friday, January 5, 2007**.
The preferred method is to e-mail entries as an attachment to canjocrocs@yahoo.com .

Adirondack Swimming does not accept NT (no time) Entries and these entries will not be imported to the meet.

No phone entries will be accepted.

Swimmers of any age can enter the senior events/relays.

Swimmers may enter in 5 individual events plus 1 relay. Please note the cut-off times listed on the enclosed schedule of events. Swimmers entering this meet must be at or slower than the listed times.

USA Swimming Registration:

All swimmers must be currently registered with USA Swimming, Inc. Registrations may be obtained from your club registrar.
ALL Adirondack Swimmers MUST be Registered with the AD Registrar by the Meet Entry Deadline.
All Adirondack Meets are reconciled for current USA Swimming Registration.
Unregistered swimmers will be removed from the meet and a \$25.00 Fine Imposed. ([Click Here for More Information](#))

Swimming Events:

Please see attached sheet. Athletes may swim 5 individual events plus 1 relay.

Scratches:

The meet will have no positive check-in. Swimmers not reporting to the blocks at the time of their event will be scratched. Please familiarize your swimmers with the scratch rule.

Warm-Ups:

Because of the large number of injuries occurring across the country during warm-ups, USA Swimming allows no diving into the pool during the warm-up period except in the designated sprint lanes. We ask that you inform your swimmers of this rule and ask them to fully cooperate with the club officials and marshals in charge of the area.

Deck Entries:

Adirondack Swimming has agreed to allow Deck Entries at AD Meets under the following conditions;

1. Deck Entries are NOT Allowed during Championship Meets
2. Athlete must be USA-S Registered and show USA-S ID Card (those already in meet have been confirmed as registered).
If athlete cannot prove USA-S Registration, Adirondack accepts Deck Registration, in meets allowing Deck Entries, to UN-AD (unattached, Adirondack) ONLY at a fee of \$100.
DECK REGISTRATIONS WILL NOT BE MADE WITH ANY TEAM ASSOCIATION, PLEASE DO NOT ASK.
3. Coach makes the request for the entry.
4. All Deck Entries will be allowed at the discretion of a combined decision of the Meet Director and the Meet Referee.

Timers:

Clubs will be required to provide timers based upon their number of entries. We will assign lanes and notify your coach or representative.

Meet Policy:

Any swimmer found in an unauthorized area will be asked to immediately leave the premises. No exceptions. Each team is responsible for supervising its members. **No one will be allowed on the deck except USA-S Registered Officials, USA-S Registered Coaches with Current Certifications, USA-S Registered Swimmers and Timers on Shift. All Officials and Coaches are required to display USA Swimming Credentials (USA Swimming Membership Card) while on deck.**

Services:

Programs, swimwear vendor, snacks and light lunches will be available.

Disabled Athletes:

Adirondack Swimming welcomes athletes with disabilities. Athletes with disabilities are required to contact the Meet Director at least 2 weeks in advance of the meet so that provisions can be made for any special accommodations.

Entry Fees:

\$3.25 per individual event (this includes the .40 travel fund surcharge) and \$6.00 per relay (this includes the \$1.00 travel fund surcharge). There is also a \$1.00 surcharge per individual swimmer for travel fund revenue. Make your entry check payable to **Canajoharie Swim Club** and mail your check and floppy diskette to;

To save mailing costs and avoid damage, Entries may be emailed and will be entered to the meet upon receipt of your check

Awards:

Medals will be awarded 1st – 3rd place and ribbons for 4th – 6th place for both individual events and relays. Heat ribbons will be awarded for swimmers 10 and under. Certificates will be awarded to swimmers achieving a national "BB" time. In an effort to encourage participation by your developmental swimmers, a team participation trophy will be awarded to the club with the largest amount of individual swimmers entered.

Officials:

There will be an official's meeting conducted promptly 30 minutes before each session. Attendance is MANDATORY to work the meet. Please sign up in official's room before the start of officials meeting.

Directions:

From Thruway Exit 29, turn right onto Rte. 5S and take your first left onto Mitchell Street (which is very short). Take your next left onto Montgomery Street. Go up Montgomery past Barclay St. and turn right onto Maple Avenue. Go up hill and turn left at blinking light onto Abeling Street and straight ahead to the school.

From the west on 5S you make a right turn on Church Street (center of town). Turn left at the stop light in the center of the street onto Montgomery Street and follow the directions above.

If you are coming in on Rte. 5 either east or west, you will cross the bridge at Palatine Bridge and follow Church Street to your second traffic light, turn left onto Montgomery Street and follow directions above.
