## Entry Rules:

This meet will have 2 Sessions. The First Session will run 9-10 and 11-12 events. The events will be scored by the USA Swimming IMX Challenge. The second Session will run IMX Challenge events for 13 & Over and traditional events for 10 & Under. 10 & Under events will score 8 & Under swimmers separately from 9-10 swimmers.

All IMX Challenge swimmers Must swim in 4 events. 10 & under swimmers may enter 5 individual events.  
All swimmers may enter only 1 relay event.

**500 Freestyle Events will have Positive Check in. Session 1, check in by 7:45am, Session 2, check in by 1:15pm.**

The eligibility of a swimmer will be determined by his or her age on January 21, 2007.

Rules from the current USA Swimming Technical Rules will be in effect.

Entries must be prepared using the Hy-Tek Meet Manager or Team Manager Software

Adirondack Swimming does not accept NT (no time) Entries and these entries will not be imported to the meet.

## USA Swimming Registration:

All swimmers must be currently registered with USA Swimming, Inc. Registrations may be obtained from your club registrar.

ALL Adirondack Swimmers MUST be Registered with the AD Registrar by the Meet Entry Deadline.

All Adirondack Meets are reconciled for current USA Swimming Registration.

Unregistered swimmers will be removed from the meet and a \$25.00 Fine Imposed. ([Click Here for More Information](#))

## Swimming Events:

All events will be swum as timed finals.

Event fees are \$3.25 per individual event, \$6.00 per relay event and a \$1.00 per swimmer surcharge.

## Warm-Ups:

Because of the large number of injuries occurring across the country during warm-ups, USA Swimming allows no diving into the pool during the warm-up period except in the designated sprint lanes. We ask that you inform your swimmers of this rule and ask them to fully cooperate with the club officials and marshals in charge of the area.

## Deck Entries:

Adirondack Swimming has agreed to allow Deck Entries at AD Meets under the following conditions;

1. Deck Entries are NOT Allowed during Championship Meets

2. Athlete must be USA-S Registered and show USA-S ID Card (those already in meet have been confirmed as registered).

**If athlete cannot prove USA-S Registration, Adirondack accepts Deck Registration, in meets allowing Deck Entries, to UN-AD (unattached, Adirondack) ONLY at a fee of \$100.**

**DECK REGISTRATIONS WILL NOT BE MADE WITH ANY TEAM ASSOCIATION, PLEASE DO NOT ASK.**

3. Coach makes the request for the entry.

4. All Deck Entries will be allowed at the discretion of a combined decision of the Meet Director and the Meet Referee.

## Timers:

Clubs will be required to provide timers based upon their number of entries. A schedule will be provided on the AD Web Site after all entries have been received. Swimmers must provide their own counters for the 500's.

**Meet Policy:**

Any swimmer found in an unauthorized area will be asked to immediately leave the premises. No exceptions. Each team is responsible for supervising its members. **No one will be allowed on the deck except USA-S Registered Officials, USA-S Registered Coaches with Current Certifications, USA-S Registered Swimmers and Timers on Shift. All Officials and Coaches are Required to display USA Swimming Credentials (USA Swimming Membership Card) while on deck.**

**Services:**

Food will be on sale throughout the meet. No food or drink is to be consumed in the pool area. A meet program will be available which will cover all sessions. A swimming equipment vendor will be selling equipment during the meet. Smoking is NOT permitted in the building. Parents, coaches and swimmers are not to bring glass containers of any kind into the pool area.

**DO NOT pack any glass containers when going to any pool.**

**Disabled Athletes:**

Adirondack Swimming welcomes athletes with disabilities. Athletes with disabilities are required to contact the Meet Director at least 2 weeks in advance of the meet so that provisions can be made for any special accommodations.

**Entry Fees:**

An entry summary sheet is included to compute your team entry fees. The entry fees are \$3.25 per individual event, (these include the \$.40 travel fund surcharge), and \$6.00 per relay (including the \$1.00 travel fund surcharge). There is also a \$1 per swimmer surcharge.

**Awards/Scoring:**

IMX Entries Must Enter and Swim in 4 Events to be Scored

All individuals, with exception of the 10 & Under events in Session 2, will be scored on the Hy-Tek Single-Age Points System. The Top 6 in each Single Age will be awarded.

In Session 2, the 10 & Unders will swim together, but will be scored as 8 & Under and 9-10. Ribbons will be awarded to the Top 8 in each individual event.

Ribbons will be awarded to all Relays placing in the Top 3.

**This is a Zones Qualifier Meet:****Officials:**

There will be an official's meeting conducted promptly 30 minutes before each session. Attendance is MANDATORY to work the meet. Please sign up in official's room before the start of officials meeting.
