Entry Rules:

The eligibility of a swimmer will be determined by his or her age on October 28, 2007. A swimmer may enter FOUR events per day plus relays. Rules from the current USA Swimming Technical Rules will be in effect. **Entries must be submitted via email using Hy-Tek software and must be received by October 17, 2007, by 5:00PM to Ann Korzun at akorzun@nycap.rr.com . Deadline for AD LSC teams for priority placement is October 10, 2007.** If the meet should be over subscribed entries will be returned on a last in first back basis. The meet committee reserves the right to return entries whose inclusion would prolong the meet.

ADIRONDACK SWIMMING DOES NOT ACCEPT NO TIME (NT) ENTRIES IN ANY OF ITS MEETS
No Time Entries will not be imported to the meet, please be certain that all entries contain an entry time.

Deck Entries:

Adirondack Swimming has agreed to allow Deck Entries at AD Meets under the following conditions;

1. Deck Entries are NOT Allowed during Championship Meets
2. Athlete must be USA-S Registered and show USA-S ID Card (those already in meet have been confirmed as registered). **If athlete cannot prove USA-S Registration, Adirondack accepts Deck Registration, in meets allowing Deck Entries, to UN-AD (unattached, Adirondack) ONLY at a fee of \$100.**
DECK REGISTRATIONS WILL NOT BE MADE WITH ANY TEAM ASSOCIATION, PLEASE DO NOT ASK.
3. Coach makes the request for the entry.
4. All Deck Entries will be allowed at the discretion of a combined decision of the Meet Director and the Meet Referee.

USA Swimming Registration:

All swimmers must be currently registered with USA Swimming, Inc. Registrations may be obtained from your club registrar. ALL Adirondack Swimmers MUST be Registered with the AD Registrar by the Meet Entry Deadline.
All Adirondack Meets are reconciled for current USA Swimming Registration.
Unregistered swimmers will be removed from the meet and a \$25.00 Fine Imposed. ([Click Here for More Information](#))

Swimming Events:

THIS IS A POSITIVE CHECK-IN MEET.

All events will be swum as timed finals. All swimmers must be checked in By the Start of Warm-ups for each session. 500's will be swum fastest heat of 12-Under Girls...fastest heat of 12-Under Boys...fastest heat of Senior Girls...fastest heat of Senior Boys, then combined.

Scratches:

All swimmers who do not positive check-in by deadline will be scratched.

Warm-Ups:

Because of the large number of injuries occurring across the country during warm-ups, USA Swimming allows no diving into the pool during the warm-up period except in the designated sprint lanes. We ask that you inform your swimmers of this rule and ask them to fully cooperate with the club officials and marshals in charge of the area.

Note: A specific Warm-up Schedule will be posted to the Adirondack Meet Schedule by October 26th.

The Adirondack Swimming Web Site is www.adirondackswimming.org click the "Meets" tab for schedule.

Special Attention Coaches and Swimmers:

We will be using Flyover Starts for this meet.

Please be familiar with this procedure and inform your swimmers prior to the meet.

Timers:

Clubs will be required to provide timers for the meet based upon their number of entries. Lane assignments will be posted in the pool and program. Swimmers in the 500 free must provide their own timers and lap counters.

Meet Policy:

Parents and coaches should see that swimmers behave in an orderly manor and dispose of and clean their area of any and all trash. Anyone found in an unauthorized area or damaging any facility property will be asked to immediately leave the premises. No exceptions. Each team is responsible for supervising its members.

No one will be allowed on the deck except USA-S Registered Officials, USA-S Registered Coaches, USA-S Registered Swimmers and Timers on Shift. All Coaches and Officials MUST Display Current and Valid USA Swimming Registration ID.

No parents (except timers) are allowed on deck.

Disabled Athletes:

Adirondack Swimming welcomes athletes with disabilities. Athletes with disabilities are required to contact the Meet Director at least 2 weeks in advance of the meet so that provisions can be made for any special accommodations.

Services:

Food will be on sale throughout the meet. No food or drink is to be consumed in the pool area. A meet program will be available which will cover all sessions. A swimming equipment vendor will be selling equipment during the meet. Smoking is NOT permitted in the building. Parents, coaches and swimmers are not to bring glass containers of any kind into the pool area.

DO NOT pack any glass containers when going to any pool.

Awards:

Individual events ribbons will be awarded for 1st - 8th place.
Relay events ribbons will be awarded to the 1st - 3rd place teams.

Entry Fees:

An entry summary sheet is included to compute your team entry fees. The entry fees are \$3.50 per individual event (this includes the \$.40 travel fund surcharge), and \$6.00 per relay (including the \$1.00 travel fund surcharge). There is also a \$1 per swimmer surcharge.

All Adirondack Meet Entries are required to be submitted using Hy-Tek Team Manager or Meet Manager Software.
