Entry Rules:

Eligibility of a swimmer will be based on his or her age on December 2, 2007. **A swimmer may enter five (5) individual events.** If this meet should be oversubscribed, entries will be returned by # of heats for the 400 IM and or the 500 free, as determined by the Meet Directors. The meet committee reserves the right to return entries whose inclusion would extend the meet. Rules from the current US Swimming Technical Rules will be in effect. Entries must be submitted on floppy diskette or CD or sent by e-mail using the Hy-Tek Meet Manager or Team Manager Software. Team entries must be received by Nov.21, 2007. USA Swimming Registration:

All swimmers must be currently registered with USA Swimming, Inc. Registrations may be obtained from your club registrar. ALL Adirondack Swimmers MUST be Registered with the AD Registrar by the Meet Entry Deadline. All Adirondack Meets are reconciled for current USA Swimming Registration. Unregistered swimmers will be removed from the meet and a \$25.00 Fine Imposed. Finals, Consolations and Scratches:

- All events will be swum as timed finals. Swimmers and coaches are responsible for knowing the events for which they are entered and for listening for any seeding announcements for all events, including relays.
- This is a PRESEEDDED MEET for SESSIONS I (one) and for Session II with exception of the 400 IM and the 500 Free
- POSITIVE CHECK-IN REQUIRED for 400IM and 500Free, by 12:15 pm, at the front entrance.
- SCRATCHES: Swimmers for 400IM and 500Free who do not check-in WILL BE SCRATCHED from those events.

Warm-ups:

Because of the large number of injuries occurring across the country during warm-ups, USA Swimming allows no diving in any pool during warm-up period except in designated sprint lanes. We ask that you inform your swimmers of this rule and ask for full cooperation with USA Officials, club officials and Meet Marshall's in charge of deck areas.

Session I: warm-ups, 7:30 a.m. to 8:25 a.m. - There will be 2-25 minute warm-ups. Warm-up assignments will be sent at a later date.
Session II: warm-ups, 12:00 p.m. to 1:10 p.m.- There will be 2- 35 minute warm-ups. Warm-up assignments will be sent at a later date
Continuous warm-up/warm down will be available after warm-ups.

Deck Entries:

- Adirondack Swimming has agreed to allow Deck Entries at AD Meets under the following conditions;
1. Deck Entries are NOT Allowed during Championship Meets
 2. Athlete must be USA-S Registered and show USA-S ID Card (those already in meet have been confirmed as registered). **If athlete cannot prove USA-S Registration, Adirondack accepts Deck Registration, in meets allowing Deck Entries, to UN-AD (unattached, Adirondack) ONLY at a fee of \$100. DECK REGISTRATIONS WILL NOT BE MADE WITH ANY TEAM ASSOCIATION, PLEASE DO NOT ASK.**
 3. Coach makes the request for the entry.
 4. All Deck Entries will be allowed at the discretion of a combined decision of the Meet Director and the Meet Referee.

Timers:

Clubs will be required to provide timers based upon their number of entries.
Swimmers have to provide their own timers and counters for the 500's.

Services:

- Food and beverage will be on sale throughout the meet. No food or drink is to be consumed in the pool area.
- A meet program will be available for purchase that covers all sessions.
- Host Team will be selling meet t-shirts, sweatshirts and miscellaneous swimming supplies.
- Smoking is not permitted in the building.
- Parents, coaches and swimmers are not allowed to bring glass containers of any kind in the pool area.

Disabled Athletes:

Adirondack Swimming welcomes athletes with disabilities. Athletes with disabilities are required to contact the Meet Director at least 2 weeks in advance of the meet so that provisions can be made for any special accommodations.

Qualifying Times:

This Meet consists of two sessions. All entries require the inclusion of a seedtime.

Adirondack does not except "No Time Entries". These entries will not be imported to the meet file.

- Session I is for age groups 8 & U and 9-10. There are no qualifying times.
- Session II is for age groups 11-12, 13 & over and Open. There are no qualifying times.

Entries must be submitted:

Digitally using the Hy-Tek Meet Manager or Team Manager software. For the purpose of the deadline, a completed team entry will consist of all entry information using Hy-Tek to prepare the entries. A check in the amount of \$25 payable to Glens Falls YMCA Gators must accompany any Team that chooses to submit entries in a different format than Hy-Tek. Glens Falls Gators are not responsible for any entry errors submitted by the teams. Entries must be received by **Wednesday November 21, 2007**. Supervision of Swimmers:

Respect for the facility is expected of everyone in attendance. Parents and coaches are responsible for ensuring that swimmers behave in an orderly manor. Everyone is responsible for cleaning his or her bullpen and deck areas of trash and disposing of the same. Bags and receptacles will be made available by the host team. Any swimmer found in an unauthorized area will be asked to immediately leave the premises. No exceptions. Each team is responsible for supervising its members. **No one will be allowed on the deck except USA-S Registered Officials, USA-S Registered Coaches with Current Certifications, USA-S Registered Swimmers and Meet Marshalls and Timers on Shift. All Officials and Coaches are Required to display USA Swimming Credentials (USA Swimming Membership Card) while on deck.**

Timers:

Teams will be required to provide timers for this meet, based upon the number of entries. Lane assignments for the day will be posted in the pool area and in the bullpen area.
