### Entry Rules:

Swimmers may enter 5 individual events plus one relay.

Please note the cut-off times listed on the enclosed schedule of events.

**Swimmers entering this meet must be slower than the listed cutoff times.**

The eligibility of a swimmer will be determined by his or her age on January 17, 2009.

Rules from the current USA Swimming Technical Rules will be in effect.

Entries must be submitted on floppy diskette or CD using the Hy-Tek Meet Manager or Team Manager Software.

The preferred method is to e-mail entries as an attachment to [canjocrocs@yahoo.com](mailto:canjocrocs@yahoo.com).

Team entries must be received by **January 7, 2009**.

Adirondack Swimming does not accept NT (no time) Entries and these entries will not be imported to the meet.

### USA Swimming Registration:

All swimmers must be currently registered with USA Swimming, Inc. Registrations may be obtained from your club registrar.

ALL Adirondack Swimmers MUST be Registered with the AD Registrar by the Meet Entry Deadline.

All Adirondack Meets are reconciled for current USA Swimming Registration.

Unregistered swimmers will be removed from the meet and a \$25.00 Fine Imposed. ([Click Here for More Information](#))

### Swimming Events:

Please see attached sheet. Athletes may swim 5 individual events and one relay.

### Scratches:

The meet will not have a positive check-in. Swimmers not reporting to the blocks at the time of their event will be scratched.

Please familiarize our swimmers with the scratch rule.

### Warm-Ups:

Because of the large number of injuries occurring across the country during warm-ups, USA Swimming allows no diving into the pool during the warm-up period except in the designated sprint lanes. We ask that you inform your swimmers of this rule and ask them to fully cooperate with the club officials and marshals in charge of the area.

Specific warm-up times are listed on events page.

### Deck Entries:

Adirondack Swimming has agreed to allow Deck Entries at AD Meets under the following conditions;

1. Deck Entries are NOT Allowed during Championship Meets

2. Athlete must be USA-S Registered and show USA-S ID Card (those already in meet have been confirmed as registered).

**If athlete cannot prove USA-S Registration, Adirondack accepts Deck Registration, in meets allowing Deck Entries, to UN-AD (unattached, Adirondack) ONLY at a fee of \$100.**

**DECK REGISTRATIONS WILL NOT BE MADE WITH ANY TEAM ASSOCIATION, PLEASE DO NOT ASK.**

3. Coach makes the request for the entry.

4. All Deck Entries will be allowed at the discretion of a combined decision of the Meet Director and the Meet Referee.

### Timers:

Clubs will be required to provide timers based upon their number of entries. We will assign lanes and will post a timing schedule on the Adirondack website.

**Meet Policy:**

Any swimmer found in an unauthorized area will be asked to immediately leave the premises. No exceptions. Each team is responsible for supervising its members. **No one will be allowed on the deck except USA-S Registered Officials, USA-S Registered Coaches with Current Certifications, USA-S Registered Swimmers and Meet Marshalls and Timers on Shift. All Officials and Coaches are Required to display USA Swimming Credentials (USA Swimming Membership Card) while on deck.**

**If, at and AD Sanctioned Meet, an individual is found on deck, acting in any coaching capacity and is determined to be out of compliance with USA Swimming requirements for coaches, that individual will be removed from the deck and the represented club will be fined \$250.**

**Services:**

Programs, swimwear vendor, snacks and light lunches will be available.

**Disabled Athletes:**

Adirondack Swimming welcomes athletes with disabilities. Athletes with disabilities are required to contact the Meet Director at least 2 weeks in advance of the meet so that provisions can be made for any special accommodations.

**Entry Fees:**

An entry summary sheet is also included to compute your team entry fees. The entry fees are \$3.50 per individual event, (these include the \$.50 travel fund surcharge), and \$6.00 per relay (including the \$1.00 travel fund surcharge). There is also a \$1 per swimmer surcharge.

**Awards:**

Medals will be awarded 1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup> place and ribbons for 4<sup>th</sup> -6<sup>th</sup> place for both events and relays. Heat ribbons will be awarded for swimmers 10 and under. Certificates will be awarded to swimmers achieving a national "BB" time. In an effort to encourage participation by your developmental swimmers, a team participation trophy will be awarded to the club with the largest number of individual swimmers entered.

**Officials:**

There will be an official's meeting conducted promptly 30 minutes before each session. Attendance is MANDATORY to work the meet. Please sign up in official's room before the start of officials meeting.

**Directions:**

Directions to Gloversville Middle School

From the Saratoga area: Take route 29 West to Route 29A. Route 29A is approximately 2 miles west of the Route 29 and Route 30 intersection. Turn right onto Route 29A and stay on Route 29A through the city of Gloversville. Once inside the city limits Rt. 29A is also known as East Fulton St. until you pass through the middle of downtown when it becomes West Fulton St. Continuing on West Fulton St. (Rt. 29A) you will pass an elementary school on your right then cross over a creek. The city limits will end. Look for the Middle School entrance on your right. Proceed up the hill and enter parking lot on your left. Use the pool entrance to gain access and not the main entrance.

From Thruway Exit 27, Amsterdam: Take Route 30 North to Route 29. Turn left onto Route 29 West to Route 29A. Route 29A is approximately 2 miles west of the Route 29 and Route 30 intersection. Turn right onto Route 29A and stay on Route 29A through the city of Gloversville. Once inside the city limits Rt. 29A is also known as East Fulton St. until you pass through the middle of downtown when it becomes West Fulton St. Continuing on West Fulton St. (Rt. 29A) you will pass an elementary school on your right then cross over a creek. The city limits will end. Look for the Middle School entrance on your right. Proceed up the hill and enter parking lot on your left. Use the pool entrance to gain access and not the main entrance.

From Thruway Exit 28, Fonda-Fultonville, Take Route 30A North through Johnstown heading north to Gloversville. At the intersection of Rt. 30A and Rt. 29A turn left onto Rt. 29A West and stay on Route 29A through the city of Gloversville. Once inside the city limits Rt. 29A is also known as East Fulton St. until you pass through the middle of downtown when it becomes West Fulton St. Continuing on West Fulton St. (Rt. 29A) you will pass an elementary school on your right then cross over a creek. The city limits will end. Look for the Middle School entrance on your right. Proceed up the hill and enter parking lot on your left. Use the pool entrance to gain access and not the main entrance.
