Entry Rules:

The eligibility of a swimmer will be determined by his or her age on January 24, 2009.

Rules from the current USA Swimming Technical Rules will be in effect.

Entries must be submitted on floppy diskette or CD using the Hy-Tek Meet Manager or Team Manager Software.

Team entries must be received by **January 14, 2009**. Deadline for AD LSC teams for priority placement **January 7, 2009**.

ADIRONDACK SWIMMING DOES NOT ACCEPT NO TIME (NT) ENTRIES IN ANY OF ITS MEETS

No Time Entries will not be imported to the meet, please be certain that all entries contain an entry time.

USA Swimming Registration:

All swimmers must be currently registered with USA Swimming, Inc. Registrations may be obtained from your club registrar.

ALL Adirondack Swimmers MUST be Registered with the AD Registrar by the Meet Entry Deadline.

All Adirondack Meets are reconciled for current USA Swimming Registration.

Unregistered swimmers will be removed from the meet a \$25.00 Fine Imposed. ([Click Here for More Information](#))

Swimming Events:

All events will be swum as timed final. Swimmers and coaches are responsible for knowing the events for which they are entered.

Warm-Ups:

Because of the large number of injuries occurring across the country during warm-ups, USA Swimming allows no diving into the pool during the warm-up period except in the designated sprint lanes. We ask that you inform your swimmers of this rule and ask them to fully cooperate with the club officials and marshals in charge of the area.

Deck Entries:

Adirondack Swimming has agreed to allow Deck Entries at AD Meets under the following conditions;

1. Deck Entries are NOT Allowed during Championship Meets
2. Athlete must be USA-S Registered and show USA-S ID Card (unless already in meet).

If athlete cannot prove USA-S Registration, Adirondack accepts Deck Registrations, when Deck Entries are allowed, to UN-AD (unattached, Adirondack) ONLY at a fee of \$100.

DECK REGISTRATIONS WILL NOT BE MADE WITH ANY TEAM ASSOCIATION, PLEASE DO NOT ASK.

3. Coach makes the request for the entry.
4. All Deck Entries will be allowed at the discretion of a combined decision of the Meet Director and the Meet Referee.

Timers:

Clubs will be required to provide timers based upon their number of entries.

Swimmers have to provide their own timers for the 500's and 1000's.

Meet Policy:

Any swimmer found in an unauthorized area will be asked to immediately leave the premises. No exceptions. Each team is responsible for supervising its members. **No one will be allowed on the deck except USA-S Registered Officials, USA-S Registered Coaches with Current Certifications, USA-S Registered Swimmers and Meet Marshalls and Timers on Shift. All Officials and Coaches are Required to display USA Swimming Credentials (USA Swimming Membership Card) while on deck.**

If, at and AD Sanctioned Meet, an individual is found on deck, acting in any coaching capacity and is determined to be out of compliance with USA Swimming requirements for coaches, that individual will be removed from the deck and the represented club will be fined \$250.

Over Subscribed Policy:

If the meet is oversubscribed, relays will be eliminated first. Then unpaid team entries will be eliminated next followed by last team entries received if necessary.

Services:

Food will be on sale throughout the meet. No food or drink will be allowed on deck. A swimming equipment vender will be selling equipment during the meet. This is a non smoking building. No glass containers are allowed in the pool area.

Disabled Athletes:

Adirondack Swimming welcomes athletes with disabilities. Athletes with disabilities are required to contact the Meet Director at least 2 weeks in advance of the meet so that provisions can be made for any special accommodations.

Entry Fees:

An entry summary sheet is also included to compute your team entry fees. The entry fees are \$3.50 per individual event (these include the \$.50 travel fund surcharge), and \$6.00 per relay (including the \$1.00 travel fund surcharge). There is also a \$1 per swimmer surcharge. Make your entry check payable to Kingston Swim Club and mail your check and floppy diskette to;

Awards:

For individual events medals will be awarded for 1st – 3rd places and ribbons for 4th -6th places.
Relay event ribbons will be awarded to the 1st - 3rd place teams.
Heat ribbons will be awarded for all individual events 12 & under

Directions:

Take the New York State Thruway to Exit 19, Kingston. Take the 3rd exit off the Rotary onto Col. Chandler Drive (587). Stay in the right lane and follow to the first light. Go straight through the light, (signs say South 32). The road bears left and merges onto Broadway (which is also 32 South). Follow Broadway for .8miles, to the Kingston High School. Take the first entrance of the horseshoe drive and drive past the front entrance of the school. The pool will be straight ahead. This is the swimmer drop off area. Park in the parking lot near the pool. If this is filled, you may need to park on Broadway or follow signs for additional parking.

Please note that the afternoon session of this meet is a dual sanctioned meet combining master's and age level swimmers. During the afternoon session, we will only be competing in 5 lanes of the pool and having a continuous warm up/cool down lane for our master's swimmers.
