#### **Entry Rules:**

The eligibility of a swimmer will be determined by his or her age on February 9, 2014.

Rules from the current USA Swimming Technical and Administrative Rules will be in effect.

Entries must be submitted electronically, using Hy-Tek, Team Unify or compatible Software and Emailed to the Meet Entry Coordinator.

Team entries must be received by the Meet Entry Coordinator by January 31, 2014

In the event the meet is oversubscribed, the meet director and meet referee will work together to determine the solution, in the best interest of the swimmers.

Attending teams will be notified of any changes via email and all changes will be posted to the AD Web Site. All fees paid for cut entries will be refunded.

Team entries must be received by Friday January 31st

Swimmers may enter a maximum of 5 events

#### **USA Swimming Registration:**

All swimmers must be currently registered with USA Swimming, Inc. Registrations may be obtained from your club registrar.

ALL Swimmers MUST be USA Swimming Registered, at the time their entries are submitted.

All Adirondack Meets are reconciled for current USA Swimming Registration.

Unregistered swimmers will be removed from the meet and a \$25.00 Fine Imposed. (Click Here for More Information)

NOTE: USA Swimming Athlete Members must be under the supervision of a USA Swimming member coach during warm-up, competition and warm-down. IF YOU ARE AN UNATTACHED ATHLETE, OR YOUR COACH WILL NOT BE ATTENDING THE MEET, YOU AND/OR YOUR COACH, MUST CONTACT THE MEET DIRECTOR OR AN ATTENDING COACH, IN ADVANCE, TO MAKE ARRANGEMENTS FOR AN ATTENDING COACH TO ASSUME RESPONSIBILITY FOR YOU.

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

These are USA Swimming Rules, there are no exceptions.

#### Swimming Events:

Session 1 will be positive check-in. All events will be swum as timed finals. All age groups need to obtain their heat and lane assignments form the heat sheets posted throughout the pool area.

#### Scratches:

N/A - No Positive check-in required

#### Warm-Ups:

Because of the large number of injuries occurring across the country during warm-ups, USA Swimming allows no diving into the pool during the warm-up period except in the designated sprint lanes. We ask that you inform your swimmers of this rule and ask them to fully cooperate with the club officials and marshals in charge of the area.

#### Timers:

Clubs will be required to provide timers based upon their number of entries.

#### **Deck Entries:**

Adirondack Swimming has agreed to allow Deck Entries at AD Meets under the following conditions;

- 1. Deck Entries are NOT Allowed during Championship Meets
- 2. Athlete must be USA-S Registered and show Proof of Registration (those already in meet have been confirmed as registered).

Acceptable forms of Proof of Registration are: USA-Swimming ID or USA-Swimming Club Portal Team Listing or Deck Pass.

If athlete cannot prove USA-S Registration, Adirondack accepts Deck Registration, to UN-AD (unattached) at an LSC fee of \$60.00 plus the current USA Swimming Registration fee.

DECK REGISTRATIONS WILL NOT BE MADE WITH ANY TEAM ASSOCIATION, PLEASE DO NOT ASK.

- 3. Coach makes the request for the entry.
- 4. All Deck Entries will be allowed at the discretion of a combined decision of the Meet Director and the Meet Referee.
- 5. Deck Entries are Subject to a \$1.00 Surcharge, Per Entry, which applies to All Entries, Individual or Relays.

#### Meet Policy:

Use of Audio or Visual Recording Devices, Including a Cell Phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. Except where venue facilities require otherwise, changing into or out of swimsuits other than locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is strongly discouraged. Any swimmer found in an unauthorized area will be asked to immediately leave the premises. No exceptions. Each team is responsible for supervising its members.

No one will be allowed on the deck except USA-S Registered Officials and USA-S Registered Coaches with Current Certifications, USA-S Registered Swimmers and Meet Marshalls and Timers on Shift. All Officials and Coaches are Required to display USA Swimming Credentials (USA Swimming Membership Card) while on deck.

If, at an AD Sanctioned Meet, an individual is found on deck, acting in any coaching capacity and is determined to be out of compliance with USA Swimming requirements for coaches, that individual will be removed from the deck and the represented club will be fined \$250.

Any swimmer found in an unauthorized area will be asked to immediately leave the premises. No exceptions. Each team is responsible for supervising its members.

#### Services:

A concession stand will be available throughout the meet. No food is to be consumed on the pool deck.

A hospitality room will be available for officials and coaches only in the office off of the pool deck.

Deep End will be selling t-shirts, sweatshirts and miscellaneous swimming supplies.

Smoking is not permitted in the building.

No glass containers allowed in the pool area.

#### **Disabled Athletes:**

Adirondack Swimming welcomes athletes with disabilities. Athletes with disabilities are required to contact the Meet Director at least 2 weeks in advance of the meet so that provisions can be made for any special accommodations.

#### **Entry Fees:**

An entry summary sheet is included to compute your team entry fees. The entry fees are \$3.50 per individual event, which includes the \$.50 AD travel fund surcharge.

ALL MANUAL ENTRIES, INCLUDING DECK ENTRIES (NON-ELECTRONIC) ARE SUBJECT TO A SURCHARGE OF \$1.00 PER ENTRY, WHICH APPLIES TO INDIVIDUAL OR RELAY ENTRIES.

Entries will be entered to the meet upon receipt of your check.

#### **Photographers:**

Any photographer or videographer, who intends to take pictures at an Adirondack Swimming sanctioned meet, must complete and submit a Photographer Registration Form to the Meet Director before commencing activity. Forms are available on the Adirondack Swimming website as well as from the Meet Director. Click here for a direct link to the registration form.

Swimmer's families, taking photos of their children from the spectator area, are not subject to this policy.

#### Awards:

Trophies will be awarded to the Top 3 finishers (male & female) in each age group (8 & U, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15 & Over) who legally and successfully finish all 5 events.

#### Scoring:

Pentathalon scoring will use an accumulation of race times. Swimmers <u>MUST</u> swim all 5 events to qualify for awards. Swimmers with a DQ in an event will add 1 minute to the slowest legal time in that event but will still be eligible for awards based on the adjusted time. Times will be broken down by age group 8 & U, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15 & Over.

#### Time Trials:

Time trials will not be offered.

#### Officials:

There will be an official's meeting conducted promptly 30 minutes before each session. Attendance is MANDATORY to work the meet. Please sign up in official's room before the start of officials meeting.
