#### SWIM MEET BID NOTES

With all of the changes passed down by USA Swimming over the past few years, much of the information collected on our past bid forms is now obsolete or has been mandated to be included on the meet announcement. We have redesigned the bid form to obtain only the basic information needed for bidding meets. We understand that it is sometimes not possible to confirm pool facilities until well after the bid due dates. That's OK ... If your meet location changes or if you have to change your meet dates, after you have submitted your bid, email the AD Sanction/Times Chair with the updated bid information.

In order to have properly attended meets, we (AD) must get our meet schedule posted in Early August for Short Course Meets and Early March for Long Course Meets.

Short Course Meet Bids are DUE by July 31<sup>st</sup>.

Long Course Meet Bids are DUE by February 28th.

Please make every effort to get bids for all meets in as early as possible.

Once the Bid Form and Fee are received, the basic meet information will be placed on the AD Meet Schedule.

Before a Sanction or Approval is Issued, only the meet date(s), meet name and location can be published. No other information can be posted or advertising done by ANYONE, until the Sanction or Approval is Issued.

### Be sure to obtain Sanctions or Approvals BEFORE you publish any information about your meet.

After you meet has been bid, be sure to follow the information provided on the Sanction or Approval Request form.

When you submit a Sanction or Approval Request, your facility and dates MUST be Confirmed.

Requests for Sanctions or Approvals must be received at least 4 weeks before the meet.

It is highly recommended that requests for Sanctions be done much earlier, at least 8 weeks before the meet. When submitting a request for sanction or approval, you must include your Meet Announcement (word DOC file) and your Meet File (or backup) from the set up meet in Meet Manager.

With the large number of USA-S changes and requirements to meet announcements, which have occurred over the past few years, Announcements for ALL Meets Beginning September 1, 2013 MUST use the Newest Posted Meet Announcement Templates from the AD Web Site.

**Dual Meets can now be Sanctioned or Approved ...** there are no special procedures for dual meets. ALL paperwork, filing processes and rules are the same as any other sanctioned or approved meet.

Note: High School Dual Meets may NOT be Observed ... Invitationals and Championships ONLY.

**NEW FOR September 1, 2013** ... An Admin Official (new position) is now required for all Sanctioned or Approved Meets.

**Minimum Officiating Requirement for Sanctioned Meets** ... Admin Official (can be a certified Referee, but not the Meet Referee), Meet Referee (can also serve as the Starter) and 2 Stroke & Turn Judges. The meet Referee will determine the need for additional positions based on the conditions of the meet.

**Minimum Officiating Requirement for Approved Meets** ... Admin Official (can be a certified Referee) and 2 Stroke & Turn Judges.

The Bid Form can be printed and filled in by hand or you can use the Adobe Fill-in Feature if you have Adobe Acrobat 9 or newer or the Free Adobe Acrobat Reader 10 or newer. If you use the Adobe Fill-in feature, be sure to use the "SAVE AS" button and name the file including the meet name. Bid forms can be mailed with your bid fee or can be saved and emailed to the Sanction/Times Chair, mailing the check separately.

Meets will be included on the AD Schedule upon receipt of the Bid Form and Bid Fee.
