CONDITIONS AND REQUIREMENTS:

The designated representative agrees, on behalf of the swimming organization applying for this Sanction, to abide by and govern this event under the Rules and Regulations of USA Swimming, Inc., Adirondack Swimming, Inc., and all other terms and conditions upon which this Sanction may be granted.

Sanctions issued to one organization cannot be transferred to another organization.

In granting this Sanction it is understood and agreed that USA Swimming, Inc. and Adirondack Swimming, Inc. shall be free from any liabilities or claims from damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event.

All Athletes must be currently registered members of USA Swimming, Inc. All meet directors, referees, starters, and stroke and turn judges, serving in an official capacity in a sanctioned event, must be currently registered members of USA Swimming, Inc. and all persons acting in any coaching capacity in a sanctioned event must be currently registered and certified coach members of USA Swimming, Inc.

Accept no Pending USA Swimming Registrations and no No Time Entries.

The organization receiving a sanction will:

1. Send a check payable to "Adirondack Swimming, Inc." to the Adirondack Administrative Vice Chair, within 15 days after the meet. The travel fund assessment is forty cents (\$0.40) per individual entry, \$1.00 per relay entry, and \$1.00 per swimmer entered in the meet. (See "Meet Financial Statement" form for further instructions)
2. File, within 45 days after the event, a financial statement setting forth all receipts and disbursements in connection with the sanctioned event, to the Adirondack Administrative Vice Chairman.
3. The organization receiving a sanction will furnish, within 15 days after written request, all receipts and vouchers related to the sanctioned event.
4. E-mail the Meet Manager file or a backup of the Meet Manager file of the meet to the AD Webmaster;
 1. When the meet is set up, no less than 30 days in advance of the meet for posting the Events File (HYV).
 2. After entries are received, no less than 5 days in advance of the meet for posting of the Psyche Sheets and to reconcile the file for any USA Swimming Registration issues (bad data or unregistered athletes).
 3. Within 5 days of the completion of the meet for posting the Results and the CL2 file and loading of the results to the USA Swimming National Database, SWIMS.

No sanction to hold any athletic event of any kind shall thereafter be issued to an organization that has failed or refused to file with Adirondack Swimming, Inc. any statement or affidavit required under any subdivision of 202.2.10, until the statement or affidavit is filed, or until such time Adirondack Swimming may determine.

Application for sanction must be accompanied by a copy of the Meet Announcement, which adheres to the contents and format provided in the "Adirondack Swimming Meet Announcement Template" (see FORMS on the AD Web Site), and will include therein a complete schedule of lanes and times for all warm-up procedures, which must be adhered to by all participants.

Entry blanks, announcement, advertising and the meet program must bear conspicuously the statement: "Held under the Sanction of USA Swimming, Inc. and Adirondack Swimming, Inc."

Adirondack Swimming allows deck entries to be taken at any Non Championship Meet. Coach Must make the request for the deck entry and the Athlete Must show his/her current USA Swimming registration ID Card as Proof of Registration. All Deck Entries will be at the discretion of BOTH the Meet Director and the Meet Referee. Deck Entries will Not be Allowed at Championship Meets.

After Sanction is issued, the AD Webmaster will post the announcement to the AD Web Site and post notice to the main page marquee of the web site.
Hosting teams need Not take any other steps to notify other teams (no mailing, etc.)

Sanction may be withheld or withdrawn by Adirondack Swimming if the competition was not conducted in accordance with the above requirements.
