Entry Rules:

The eligibility of a swimmer will be determined by his or her age on October 24, 2010. A swimmer may enter FOUR events per day plus One relay. Rules from the current USA Swimming Technical Rules will be in effect. Entries must be submitted via email using Hy-Tek software and **must be received by October 13, 2010, by 5:00PM to Patty Rowledge at** <u>prowledg@nycap.rr.com</u>. The deadline for AD LSC teams for priority placement is October 6, 2010. Please be certain you receive a reply to your email with entries ... follow up if you do NOT receive a reply. In the event the meet is oversubscribed, the meet director and meet referee will work together to determine the solution, in the best interest of the swimmers.

Deck Entries:

Adirondack Swimming has agreed to allow Deck Entries at AD Meets under the following conditions;

1. Deck Entries are NOT Allowed during Championship Meets

2. Athlete must be USA-S Registered and show USA-S ID Card (those already in meet have been confirmed as registered).

If athlete cannot prove USA-S Registration, Adirondack accepts Deck Registration, in meets allowing Deck Entries,

to UN-AD (unattached, Adirondack) ONLY, at a fee of \$100.

DECK REGISTRATIONS WILL NOT BE MADE WITH ANY TEAM ASSOCIATION, PLEASE DO NOT ASK.

3. Coach makes the request for the entry.

- 4. All Deck Entries will be allowed at the discretion of a combined decision of the Meet Director and the Meet Referee.
- 5. There is a \$1 per entry surcharge for manual entries (individual or relay).

USA Swimming Registration:

All swimmers must be currently registered with USA Swimming, Inc. Registrations may be obtained from your club registrar. ALL Swimmers MUST be Registered, for the date(s) encompassing the meet, with the AD Registrar by the Meet Entry Deadline. All Adirondack Meets are reconciled for current USA Swimming Registration.

Unregistered swimmers will be removed from the meet and a \$25.00 Fine Imposed. (Click Here for More Information)

NOTE: ALL ATHLETES ATTENDING ANY SANCTIONED MEET, MUST BE UNDER THE DIRECT SUPERVISION OF A CURRENTLY RESGISTERED AND CERTIFIED, USA SWIMMING COACH. IF YOU ARE AN UNATTACHED ATHLETE, OR YOUR COACH WILL NOT BE ATTENDING THE MEET, YOU AND/OR YOUR COACH, MUST CONTACT THE MEET DIRECTOR OR AN ATTENDING COACH, IN ADVANCE, TO MAKE ARRANGEMENTS FOR AN ATTENDING COACH TO ASSUME RESPONSIBILITY FOR YOU.

This is a USA Swimming Rule, there are no exceptions.

Any swimmer entered in the meet, unaccompanied by a USA Swimming member coach, must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

Swimming Events:

THIS IS A POSITIVE CHECK-IN MEET.

All events will be swum as timed finals. All swimmers must be checked in by the start of warm-ups for each session. 500's will be swum fastest heat of 12&under girls...fastest heat of 12&under boys...then alternating 12&under girls' and boys' heats, and the last heat may be combined. Then the fastest heat of Senior Girls...fastest heat of Senior Boys...then alternating senior girls' and boys' heats, and the last heat may be combined. We will be using Flyover Starts for this meet. Please inform your swimmers prior to the meet.

Scratches:

All swimmers who do not positive check-in by the deadline will be scratched.

Warm-Ups:

Because of the large number of injuries occurring across the country during warm-ups, USA Swimming allows no diving into the pool during the warm-up period except in the designated sprint lanes. We ask that you inform your swimmers of this rule and ask them to fully cooperate with the club officials and marshals in charge of the area. Note: A specific warm-up schedule will be posted to the Adirondack Swimming website. (www.adirondackswimming.org click the "Meets" tab for schedule)

Bull Pen:

Swimmer who are 8 and under are expected to line up in the bull pen area for the 25 yard events only.

Timers:

Clubs will be required to provide timers for the meet based upon their number of entries. Lane assignments will be posted to the Adirondack Swimming website (<u>www.adirondackswimming.org</u>) and in the meet program. Swimmers in the 500 free must provide their own timers and lap counters.

Meet Policy:

Parents and coaches should see that swimmers behave in an orderly manner and dispose of and clean their area of any and all trash. Anyone found in an unauthorized area or damaging any facility property will be asked to immediately leave the premises. No exceptions. Each team is responsible for supervising its members.

No one will be allowed on the deck except USA-S Registered Officials, USA-S Registered Coaches with Current Certifications, USA-S Registered Swimmers and Meet Marshals and Timers on Shift. All Officials and Coaches are Required to display USA Swimming Credentials (USA Swimming Membership Card) while on deck.

If, at and AD Sanctioned Meet, an individual is found on deck, acting in any coaching capacity and is determined to be out of compliance with USA Swimming requirements for coaches, that individual will be removed from the deck and the represented club will be fined \$250.

No parents (except timers and meet marshals ON SHIFT) are allowed on deck.

Disabled Athletes:

Adirondack Swimming welcomes athletes with disabilities. Athletes with disabilities are required to contact the Meet Director at least 2 weeks in advance of the meet so that provisions can be made for any special accommodations.

Services:

Food will be on sale throughout the meet. No food or drink is to be consumed in the pool area. A meet program will be available which will cover all sessions, and heat sheets will be available with the purchase of a program. A swimming equipment vendor will be selling equipment during the meet. Smoking is NOT permitted in the building. Parents, coaches and swimmers are not to bring glass containers of any kind into the pool area. **DO NOT pack any glass containers when going to any pool.**

Awards:

Individual events ribbons will be awarded for $1^{st} - 3^{th}$ place. Relay events ribbons will be awarded to the $1^{st} - 3^{rd}$ place teams.

Entry Fees:

An entry summary sheet is included to compute your team entry fees. The entry fees are \$3.75 per individual event (this includes the \$.50 travel fund surcharge), and \$6.00 per relay (including the \$1.00 travel fund surcharge). There is also a \$1 per swimmer surcharge.

All Adirondack Meet Entries are required to be submitted using Hy-Tek Team Manager or Meet Manager Software.
