Entry Rules:

Swimmers entering this meet must be slower than the listed cut off times. Please note the cut off times listed on the schedule of events. USA Swimming Registration:

All swimmers must be currently registered with USA Swimming, Inc. Registrations may be obtained from your club registrar.

All Swimmers MUST be Registered, with the AD Registrar, by the Meet Entry Deadline.

All Adirondack Meets are reconciled for current USA Swimming Registration.

Unregistered swimmers will be removed from the meet and a \$25.00 Fine Imposed. NOTE: ALL ATHLETES ATTENDING ANY SANCTIONED MEET, MUST BE UNDER THE DIRECT SUPERVISION OF A CURRENTLY REGISTERED AND CERTIFIED, USA SWIMMING COACH. IF YOU ARE AN UNATTACHED ATHLETE, OR YOUR COACH WILL NOT BE ATTENDING THE MEET, YOU AND/OR YOUR COACH, MUST CONTACT THE MEET DIRECTOROR AN ATTENDING COACH, IN ADVANCE, TO MAKE ARRANGEMENTS FOR AN ATTENDING COACH TO ASSUME RESPONSIBILITY FOR YOU. This is a USA Swimming Rule, there are no exceptions.

Any swimmer entered in the meet, unaccompanied by a USA Swimming member coach, must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

Swimming Events:

Please see attached sheet.

All events will be pre-seeded and swum as timed finals. Athletes may swim 5 individual events and one relay.

Scratches:

The meet will be pre-seeded. Swimmers not reporting to the blocks at the time of their event will be scratched. Please familiarize our swimmers with the scratch rule.

Warm-Ups:

Because of the large number of injuries occurring across the country during warm-ups, USA Swimming allows no diving into the pool during the warm-up period except in the designated sprint lanes. We ask that you inform your swimmers of this rule and ask them to fully cooperate with the club officials and marshals in charge of the area.

Timers:

Clubs will be required to provide timers based upon their number of entries. Swimmers have to provide their own timers for the 400 IM's, 500's and 1650's.

Deck Entries:

Adirondack Swimming has agreed to allow Deck Entries at AD Meets under the following conditions;

1. Deck Entries are NOT Allowed during Championship Meets

2. Athlete must be USA-S Registered and show USA-S 10 Card (those already in meet have been confirmed as registered). If athlete cannot prove USA-S Registration, Adirondack accepts Deck Registration, in meets allowing Deck Entries, to UN-AD (unattached, Adirondack) ONLY at a fee of \$100.

DECK REGISTRATIONS WILL NOT BE MADE WITH ANY TEAM ASSOCIATION, PLEASE DO NOT ASK.

3. Coach makes the request for the entry.

4. All Deck Entries will be allowed at the discretion of a combined decision of the Meet Director and the Meet Referee.

5. Deck Entries are Subject to a \$1.00 Surcharge, Per Entry, which applies to All Entries, Individual or Relays.

Meet Policy:

Use of Audio or Visual Recording Devices, Including a Cell Phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. Any swimmer found in an unauthorized area will be asked to immediately leave the premises. No exceptions. Each team is responsible for supervising its members. No one will be allowed on the deck except USA-S Registered Officials, USA-S Registered Coaches with Current Certifications, USA-S Registered Swimmers and Meet Marshalls and Timers on Shift. All Officials and Coaches are Required to display USA Swimming Credentials (USA Swimming Membership Card) while on deck. If, at and AD USA Swimming requirements for coaches, that individual will be removed from the deck and the represented club will be fined \$250.

Services:

Programs, Swimwear Vendor, Snacks, Breakfast and Light Lunches will be available.

Disabled Athletes:

Adirondack Swimming welcomes athletes with disabilities. Athletes with disabilities are required to contact the Meet Director at least 2 weeks in advance of the meet so that provisions can be made for any special accommodations.

Photographers:

Any photographer or videographer, who intends to take pictures at an Adirondack Swimming sanctioned meet, must complete and submit a Photographer Registration Form to the Meet Director before commencing activity. Forms are available on the Adirondack Swimming website as well as from the Meet Director. <u>Click here for a direct link to the registration form.</u> Swimmer's families, taking photos of their children from the spectator area, are not subject to this policy.

Entry Fees:

An entry summary sheet is included to compute your team entry fees. The entry fees are \$3.50 per individual event, which includes the \$.50 AD travel fund surcharge, \$6.00 per relay, which includes the \$1.00 AD travel fund surcharge and a \$1.00 per swimmer surcharge. All Manual (non-electronic) Entries are subject to a \$1.00 Surcharge per entry.

To save mailing costs and avoid damage, Entries should be emailed and will be entered to the meet upon receipt of your check.

Awards:

Medals will be awarded 1st - 3rd place and ribbons for 4th -6th place for both events and relays. Heat ribbons will be awarded for swimmers 10 and under in addition Certificates will also be awarded to swimmers achieving a national "BB" time. In an effort to encourage participation by your developmental swimmers, a team participation trophy will be awarded to the club with the largest number of individual swimmers entered.

Officials:

There will be an official's meeting conducted promptly 30 minutes before each session. Attendance is MANDATORY to work the meet. Please sign up in official's room before the start of officials meeting.
