Any swimmer may swim in the Open Events.

### **USA Swimming Registration:**

All swimmers must be currently registered with USA Swimming, Inc. Registrations may be obtained from your club registrar.

ALL Adirondack Swimmers MUST be Registered with the AD Registrar by the Meet Entry Deadline.

All Adirondack Meets are reconciled for current USA Swimming Registration.

Unregistered swimmers will be removed from the meet and a \$25.00 Fine Imposed. (Click Here for More Information)

NOTE: ALL ATHLETES ATTENDING ANY SANCTIONED MEET, MUST BE UNDER THE DIRECT SUPERVISION OF A CURRENTLY RESGISTERED AND CERTIFIED, USA SWIMMING COACH MEMBER. IF YOU ARE AN UNATTACHED ATHLETE, OR YOUR COACH WILL NOT BE ATTENDING THE MEET, YOU AND/OR YOUR COACH, MUST CONTACT THE MEET DIRECTOR OR AN ATTENDING COACH, IN ADVANCE, TO MAKE ARRANGEMENTS FOR AN ATTENDING COACH TO ASSUME RESPONSIBILITY FOR YOU. This is a USA Swimming Rule, there are no exceptions.

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

#### Swimming Events:

All events will be swum as timed finals. The morning and afternoon sessions will be pre-seeded.

Positive check-in for the Mid-session only. This will be deck seeded.

The mid-session events will be swum combined fastest to slowest

#### **Scratches:**

Any swimmer who does not check in for the Mid-session will be scratched. No Exceptions.

#### Warm-Ups:

Because of the large number of injuries occurring across the country during warm-ups, USA Swimming allows no diving into the pool during the warm-up period except in the designated sprint lanes. We ask that you inform your swimmers of this rule and ask them to fully cooperate with the club officials and marshals in charge of the area.

Morning Session Warm-ups 7:30 – 7:50 AM 9-10 age group, 7:50 – 8:10 AM 8 and Under age group, 8:10 – 8:25 AM

Combined and Sprints.

Mid-Session Positive Check-in by 11:30 AM.

Warm-ups to start 20 minutes prior to the start of the session but not before 11:30 AM

Afternoon Session Warm-ups 1:30 – 1:50 PM 13 and over age groups, 1:50 – 2:10 PM 11-12 age group, 2:10 – 2:25 PM

#### Timers:

Clubs will be required to provide timers based upon their number of entries.

Swimmers have to provide their own timers and counters for all mid-session events

#### **Deck Entries:**

Adirondack Swimming has agreed to allow Deck Entries at AD Meets under the following conditions;

- 1. Deck Entries are NOT Allowed during Championship Meets
- 2. Athlete must be USA-S Registered and show USA-S ID Card (those already in meet have been confirmed as registered).

If athlete cannot prove USA-S Registration, Adirondack accepts Deck Registration, in meets allowing Deck Entries, to UN-AD (unattached, Adirondack) ONLY at a fee of \$102.

DECK REGISTRATIONS WILL NOT BE MADE WITH ANY TEAM ASSOCIATION, PLEASE DO NOT ASK.

- 3. Coach makes the request for the entry.
- 4. All Deck Entries will be allowed at the discretion of a combined decision of the Meet Director and the Meet Referee.
- 5. Deck Entries are Subject to a \$1.00 Surcharge, Per Entry, which applies to All Entries, Individual or Relays.

#### **Meet Policy:**

Use of Audio or Visual Recording Devices, Including a Cell Phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. Any swimmer found in an unauthorized area will be asked to immediately leave the premises. No exceptions. Each team is responsible for supervising its members. No one will be allowed on the deck except USA-S Registered Officials, USA-S Registered Coaches with Current Certifications, USA-S Registered Swimmers and Meet Marshalls and Timers on Shift. All Officials and Coaches are Required to display USA Swimming Credentials (USA Swimming Membership Card) while on deck.

If, at and AD Sanctioned Meet, an individual is found on deck, acting in any coaching capacity and is determined to be out of compliance with USA Swimming requirements for coaches, that individual will be removed from the deck and the represented club will be fined \$250.

#### Services:

Food will be available throughout the meet in the school cafeteria. No food or drink is allowed outside the cafeteria. No glass containers in the facility at all. There is NO SMOKING in the building or on school grounds. Meet programs will be available for purchase.

#### **Disabled Athletes:**

Adirondack Swimming welcomes athletes with disabilities. Athletes with disabilities are required to contact the Meet Director at least 2 weeks in advance of the meet so that provisions can be made for any special accommodations.

#### **Entry Fees:**

An entry summary sheet is also included to compute your team entry fees. The entry fees are \$3.50 per individual event, (this includes the \$.40 travel fund surcharge), and \$6.00 per relay (including the \$1.00 travel fund surcharge). There is also a \$1 per swimmer surcharge.

ALL MANUAL ENTRIES, INCLUDING DECK ENTRIES (NON-ELECTRONIC) ARE SUBJECT TO

A SURCHARGE OF \$1.00 PER ENTRY, WHICH APPLIES TO INDIVIDUAL OR RELAY ENTRIES.

There will be an official's meeting conducted promptly 30 minutes before each session. Attendance is MANDATORY to work the meet. Please sign up in official's room before the start of officials meeting.

From the Saratoga area: Take route 29 West to Route 29A. Route 29A is approximately 2 miles west of the Route 29 and Route 30 intersection. Turn right onto Route 29A and stay on Route 29A through the city of Gloversville. Once inside the city limits Rt. 29A is also known as East Fulton St. until you pass through the middle of downtown when it becomes West Fulton St. Continuing on West Fulton St. (Rt. 29A) you will pass an elementary school on your right then cross over a creek. The city limits will end. Look for the Middle School entrance on your right. Proceed up the hill and enter parking lot on your left. Use the pool entrance to gain access and not the main entrance.

From Thruway Exit 27, Amsterdam: Take Route 30 North to Route 29. Turn left onto Route 29 West to Route 29A. Route 29A is approximately 2 miles west of the Route 29 and Route 30 intersection. Turn right onto Route 29A and stay on Route 29A through the city of Gloversville. Once inside the city limits Rt. 29A is also known as East Fulton St. until you pass through the middle of downtown when it becomes West Fulton St. Continuing on West Fulton St. (Rt. 29A) you will pass an elementary school on your right then cross over a creek.
