Entry Rules:

The eligibility of a swimmer will be determined by his or her age on February 22nd 2020.

Rules from the current USA Swimming Technical and Administrative Rules will be in effect.

Entries must be submitted electronically, using Hy-Tek, Team Unify or compatible Software and Emailed to the Meet Entry Coordinator.

Team entries must be received by the Meet Entry Coordinator by Wednesday February 12th 2020 at 5:00pm

Swimmers may enter a max of three (3) individual events and 1 relay per day or 2 Individual events and 2 relays.

In the event the meet is oversubscribed, the Meet Director may cut Relays in order to achieve the desired timeline. If after removing relays, the meet is still oversubscribed, the Meet Director and Meet Referee will work together to determine how entries are removed, with the best interest of the swimmers in mind.

If the meet is oversubscribed or undersubscribed, Meet and/or Session Start Times may need to be changed. Attending teams will be notified of any changes via email and all changes will be posted to the AD Web Site. All fees paid for cut entries will be refunded.

202.3.2 At a sanctioned competitive event, USA Swimming athlete members must be under the supervision of a USA Swimming member coach during warm-up, competition, and warm-down. The Meet Director or Meet Referee may assist the swimmer in making arrangements for such supervision, but it is the swimmer's responsibility to make such arrangements prior to the start of the meet.

202.3.4A Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement

USA Swimming Registration:

No swimmer will be permitted to compete unless the swimmer is a member as provided in Article 302

Registrations may be obtained from your club registrar. All Adirondack Meets are reconciled for current USA Swimming Registration. Unregistered swimmers will be removed from the meet and a \$25.00 Fine Imposed. (Click Here for More Information)

Swimming Events:

All events are timed finals. Starts will be flyover starts please inform your swimmers prior to the meet. Positive check in will be required for the 400 IM and 500 free. Swimmers who are not checked in by 8:45am will be scratched.

12 and under events will be scored will be scored as 8 and under, 9-10, 11-12

Open events will be scored 10 and under, 11-12, 13-14, 15 and over 13 and over events will be scored 13-14, 15 and over. Mixed relays must have 2 girls and 2 boys

Relays:

Mixed relays must have 2 male and 2 female swimmers entered that satisfy the age requirement.

Scratches:

All swimmers must be checked-in at the timing table for the 400IM and 500 Free. Swimmers who positively check in for an event and do not show up for the event, will be disqualified from that event and their next scheduled individual event. This scratch rule is for all swimmers, including 10 &under athletes.

Timers:

Clubs will be required to provide timers based upon their number of entries Swimmers have to provide their own timers for the 400 IM's, 500's, 1650's, etc.

Warm-Ups:

Because of the large number of injuries occurring across the country during warm-ups, USA Swimming allows no diving into the pool during the warm-up period except in the designated sprint lanes. We ask that you inform your swimmers of this rule and ask them to fully cooperate with the club officials and marshals in charge of the area.

Time Trials:

Time trials may be held for swimmers trying to qualify for Gold Championships, Senior Cut Times or Faster. Each time trial is \$7.00. Coaches must request a time trial from the meet referee and meet director and they will determine when the time trial will be conducted. The meet referee and meet director reserve the right to refuse time trials longer than 200 yards.

Deck Entries:

Deck Entries will NOT be accepted at this meet.

Meet Policy:

Use of Audio or Visual Recording Devices, Including a Cell Phone, is not permitted behind the starting blocks, including any spectator area behind the starting blocks, in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.

Changing into or out of swimsuits other than locker rooms or other designated areas is prohibited.

Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.

No one will be allowed on the deck except USA-S Registered Officials and USA-S Registered Coaches with Current Certifications, USA-S Registered Swimmers and Meet Marshalls and Timers on Shift.

All Officials and Coaches are Required to display USA Swimming Credentials (USA Swimming Membership Card) while on deck. If, at an AD Sanctioned Meet, an individual is found on deck, acting in any coaching capacity and is determined to be out of compliance with USA Swimming requirements for coaches, that individual will be removed from the deck and the represented club will be fined \$250.

Any swimmer found in an unauthorized area will be asked to immediately leave the premises. No exceptions. Each team is responsible for supervising its members.

Services:

Programs and Concessions available during the meet.

Disabled Athletes:

Adirondack Swimming welcomes athletes with disabilities. Athletes with disabilities are required to contact the Meet Director at least 2 weeks in advance of the meet so that provisions can be made for any special accommodations.

Entry Fees:

An entry summary sheet is included to compute your team entry fees. The entry fees are \$2.00 per individual event, which includes the \$.50 AD travel fund surcharge, \$2.00 per relay, which includes the \$1.00 AD travel fund surcharge and a \$2.00 per swimmer surcharge ALL MANUAL ENTRIES, INCLUDING DECK ENTRIES (NON-ELECTRONIC) ARE SUBJECT TO A SURCHARGE OF \$1.00 PER ENTRY, WHICH APPLIES TO INDIVIDUAL ENTRIES.

Entries will be entered to the meet upon receipt of your check.

Photographers:

Only Professional Photographers or Videographers hired by the host team or Press Photographers, who have been approved in advance by the meet director, will be allowed on deck. A Photographer Registration form must be completed and submitted to the meet director for approval, prior to the meet. Forms are available on the Adirondack Swimming website as well as from the Meet Director.

Swimmer's families, taking photos of their children from the spectator area, are not subject to this policy.

Awards:

Medals will be awarded to 1st-3rd in individual events.

Ribbons will be awarded for places 4th to 6th place for individual events and 1st place for relays

12 and under events will be scored as 8 and under, 9-10, 11-12

Open events will be scored as 10 and under, 11-12, 13-14, 15 and over

13 and over events will be scored as 13-14, 15 and over

Scoring:

Finals and consolations will be scored according to USA Swimming rules.

12 & under events will be scored as 8 and under, 9-10, 11-12

13 & over events will be scored as 13-14, 15 & over

Open events will be scored as 10 and under, 11-12, 13-14, 15 & over

Officials:

There will be an official's meeting conducted promptly 30 minutes before each session. Attendance is MANDATORY to work the meet. Please sign up in official's room before the start of officials meeting.
