



## Process of Becoming a USA-Swimming Official

- 1) Contact JoAnn Faucett AD Officials Chair (cell 518 496-6136) <a href="mailto:faucettjm@aol.com">faucettjm@aol.com</a>
- 2) Application found on adirondackswimming.org site under Official
- 3) Attend an in-person swimming clinic if possible
- 4) Set up your personal USA-Swimming login (usaswimming.org)
- 5) Login, Education, Course Catalog, USA-S University, highlight officials' button,
- 6) Complete online: Concussion Protocol Training, Foundation of Officiating Stroke & Turn Certification, all free of charge
- 7) Login, Education, Course Catalog, USA-S University, highlight Safe Sport button, complete Athlete Protection Training (APT) 90-minute course, refresher course taken annually, free of charge
- 8) Complete Background Check requirement (search Background Check on USA-S University), renewal every 2 years, there is a charge, fee depending on county which you reside, how many times you have moved, name changes
- 9) Become a member of USA-Swimming either through your team registrar or Adirondack Swimming registrar Bill Faucett (office@adirondackswimming.org), make sure to pick roll of official as category of membership
- 10)Shadow 4 sessions with a certified official, free stye session excluded
